Dear ERandEM IWG Participants,

Thank you for your ongoing commitment to the important work of the Electronic Reporting and Electronic Monitoring (ERandEM) intersessional working group (IWG). The Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) is honoured to assume the lead for the Commission's initiative on EM, and I look forward to progressing the work of the IWG, alongside you, as the Chair.

Let me take the opportunity to extend my sincere thanks to the outgoing IWG Chair, Dr. Shelton Harley for his leadership and contribution to progressing the work towards the adoption of the Commission's Interim EM standards at WCPFC21 in Fiji.

I have met with the WCPFC Secretariat staff to discuss the Commission's 2025 work plan for the ERandEM IWG. In addition, I have reached out to the Chair of the ROP IWG, recognizing the direct relevance of their work to the tasks ahead for the ERandEM IWG and have also engaged with WCPFC Regional Observer Programme (ROP) consultant, Mr. Karl Staisch to gain a deeper understanding of the WCPFC ROP Audit process which is of relevance to designing assurance and audit mechanisms for the WCPFC EM Programme.

The WCPFC Secretariat has also brought to my attention some other Commission work streams that may be relevant for the work of the ERandEM IWG. These include the intersessional working groups reviewing CMM 2017-02 (<a href="Port State Minimum Standards">Port State Minimum Standards</a>) and developing High Seas Boarding and Inspection Guidelines. I look forward to further discussions to better understand possible implications for our work as they progress.

In considering how best to approach this year's work plan I have mapped out my proposed pathway which is attached. This takes into consideration the need for some flexibility in scheduling meetings of the IWG but also recognises that progress will invariably depend on taking opportunities within an already demanding regional fisheries meeting calendar. I would welcome your feedback on this approach and intend to coordinate closely with the WCPFC Secretariat to manage this process effectively.

To the extent possible, I aim to advance the IWG work plan electronically, including making use of Commission circulars, email and virtual meetings. The Secretariat will also maintain the WCPFC webpage for this IWG.
