Dear Lara and Ana,

Please find below the requested elements about the actions taken by France to remedy the non-compliance cases you mentioned last July.

These following elements were duly submitted on the website of the WCPFC (<https://intra.wcpfc.int/Lists/Address%20CMR2015%20Issues/AllItems.aspx>). Unfortunately, I failed to upload the large file (.xlsx) detailing all the irregularities observed during inspections from 2015 to 2017. This is why I am sending you by email this 17,3 Mo Excel spreadsheet. Do not hesitate to come back to me if you experienced some difficulties to download it.

(1) Provide full report on high seas boarding and inspection (HSBI) (CMM 2006-08-30):

@13 September 2017: France has the honour to transmit to the WCPFC authorities an Excel sheet (17,3 Mo) detailing all the irregularities observed during inspections at sea / dockside investigations / others, carried out since the creation of the Maritime intelligence and data fusion center in French Polynesia (Centre de fusion du renseignement maritime, CFIM in French) from 2015 to 2017.

All the scanned reports of the relevant facts are attached to this document.

(2) Annual reporting by members on the HSBI carried out by its authorized inspection vessels (CMM 2006-08 40):

@13 September 2017: France has forwarded its inspection reports from May 2015 to July 2017 (cf. Excel sheet attached).

France undertakes to renew this transmission every year to the WCPFC authorities.

(3) Reporting requirement for MCS actions related to large scale driftnet fishing on the high seas (CMM 2008-04 05):

@13 September 2017: France confirms not to be concerned by the actions related to large scale driftnet fishing on the high seas.

Dear Fabien,

Thank you for your email below advising submission of France's AR Part 2. A quick review for completeness show that France hasn't completed one of the list that make up the Annual Report Part 2, which is Addressing CMR-2015 issues (underline in red in the picture below). This list is relevant to France because France had a score of Non-compliant for three obligations in the final CMR report adopted by WCPFC13. CMM 2015-07 para 36, indicates that CCM shall include in its AR Part 2 any actions it has taken to address non-compliance identified in the CMR from previous years.

By way of background the three provisions mentioned in the Addressing CMR-215 issues list received scores of non-compliant because there were some supporting details that would have been helpful to have received from France in last years Annual Report Part 2, and because France was not present at TCC to provide supplementary explanations. It would be helpful if France could complete this list as required under CMM 2015-07 para 36 as this is assess in the compliance review process at TCC, and perhaps consider if supplementary responses could be provided for the same paragraphs in Annual Report Part 2.
