INFORMATION COMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY (ICT) MANAGER to commence mid 2016

The base salary is from **SDR 44,771 to 60,578** per annum. This is equivalent to **US\$62,521 to US\$84,595** at the current exchange rate. The total salary package comprises of base salary, Cost of Living Differential Allowance, Housing, Superannuation and Location Allowance.

The Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission was established to ensure, through effective management, the long-term conservation and sustainable use of highly migratory fish stocks in the western and central Pacific Ocean. The Commission's Secretariat which is located in Pohnpei, Federated States of Micronesia now invites applications for the position of ICT Manager.

The ICT Manager is responsible for the design, development and management the ICT requirements of the Secretariat; establishment and maintenance of necessary databases, networks and communications services; management of service agreements with external providers for the provision of data services to the Commission and the efficient operations of the Commission's ICT systems. In addition the ICT Manager will liaison with key stakeholders, particularly in other Regional Fisheries Management Organisations, on ICT, data management, information exchange and communication systems.

Applicants are required to have a proven record of achievement that demonstrates their ability to successfully undertake the role. Appropriate tertiary qualification preferably in IT, communications technology or data management, including recognised professional certifications is required.
