In accordance with Article 26 of the Convention on the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean and relevant paragraphs of Conservation and Management Measure 2006-08, please see included details of two additional U.S. vessels that may be assigned to boarding and inspection activities under the WCPFC High Seas Boarding and Inspection Procedures, enclosure (1). Please note that cutters BERTHOLF and WAESCHE are both clearly marked and identifiable as being in U.S. government service. The crew aboard each vessel is properly trained in carrying out boarding and inspection activities at sea in accordance with standards and procedures as adopted by the Commission. Request these vessels be added to the list of inspection vessels.

Additionally, cutters HAMILTON (inspection vessel #15) and CHASE (inspection vessel #13) have been decommissioned and are no longer in the service of the government of the United States of America. Please remove these vessels from the list of inspection vessels.
